

# Brilliant Broadmayne

## Summer 1

In English we will be reading several books which will help to support us to make comparisons between where we live and other places. We will be looking in depth at the stories to develop our comprehension skills. We will continue focusing on writing sentences using the correct punctuation throughout Year 1 and we will also continue to use the 'pre-cursive' handwriting style. We will learn to add the prefix 'un' to our writing and we will learn to add suffixes such as 'ing', 'er', 'est' and 'ed' to form the past tense. We will write a poem based on our senses.

In ICT we will talk about the importance of staying safe when using the internet. We will use the chromebooks to access websites to support our learning.

In Maths we will be looking at numbers up to 50. We will be learning to understand place value and we will learn to use a 100 square. We will continue to practice addition and subtraction and will visit multiplication and division. We will practice counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will practice explaining our answers to calculations or talk about our thinking behind our problem solving.

In Art we will be carrying out art in our natural environment at Broadmayne to support our geography work. In Design Technology we will be making our own houses with junk modelling. We will incorporate a hinge for the door and windows.

In Music we will practise singing during singalong. We will also learn new songs to help with our learning. We will practise keeping a steady beat. We will continue to experiment with music using a range of instruments.

In Heartsmart, our focus this half term will be 'Fake is a mistake.' We will also think about friendship, what it means to be a good friend and what we can do if we have a problem.

In Science we will be learning to name the common plants, trees and animals that we find around Broadmayne. We will use our senses to work scientifically and carry out several investigations. We will also look at the changes around us in the season as we head from Spring to Summer. We will revisit our learning on materials as we think about houses and homes.

In History we will be finding out about how our school has changed. We will look at our classroom and the school building. We will be writing questions and interviewing a member of staff who has worked at the school for a long time. We will see what we can find out! We will look at the changes in houses and homelife. In geography, we will learn about the differences between urban and rural settings. We will look at the geography of our school. In RE we will learn about Judaism and why Shabbat is important to Jewish people.

In PE we will be taking part in cricket and tag rugby. We will also be going to Forest School and exploring outdoors to support our learning and development.
