Dear Parents and Carers.

Bringing Toys and Other Items into School

We seem to have a rise in the amount of items being brought into school recently. Can I remind our families that toys and other items are **not allowed** in school unless this has been previously agreed with the class teacher - for instance for Show and Tell sessions. In these cases please ensure items are only brought in on the correct day.

This includes transitional objects and fiddle toys- these can only be brought in if the class teacher has agreed them. This rule is for the safety of our children and to ensure property does not go missing.

Having had a child of my own who was particularly keen on taking things into school without me knowing, it might be worth occasionally frisking your child to ensure they are helping to keep this rule!
