#### **World Book Week**

World Book Week is rapidly approaching! This year it will run from Monday 27th February to Friday 3rd March, and the school theme will be Celebrating Diversity. There will be lots of activities taking place across the week, the dates for your diaries are as follows:

On **Monday 27th February** we will be enjoying Books at Bedtime. Starting at 5.30pm we invite children to come back to school with their parents and carers to enjoy listening to some bedtime stories and a hot chocolate and biscuit. Everyone (staff included!) will be in their pyjamas and dressing gowns to make this a really warm and cosy event! Adults are asked to stay - there will be hot drinks and cake available in the hall while you are waiting for your children. Please note this is a change to the date that we originally advertised

On **Tuesday 28th February**, we are planning on holding a book swap for the children in school.
