Dear Parents and Carers,

As we wait for further unlocking of Covid restrictions, the school continues to find ways to bring back as much normality as possible! We are pleased to have begun re-introducing some sports clubs, and assemblies are happening again, albeit in a slightly smaller capacity than previously. We are looking at how we can bring visitors back into school as safely as possible, and the FABS have been working really hard to get the pool to a point where it will be ready to safely use from next half term (let's hope the weather cheers up a little by then, too!)

Covid 19 Update

Some of you may have listened to the government announcement about the continued unlocking of Covid restrictions starting next Monday. The updated guidance for schools from the DfE was released soon after, but disappointingly there are very few changes to it, and so school will continue with all current restrictions in place for the time being.

We are, however, making one change which we hope will be useful for everyone. We are planning to make the office more accessible to parents than it has been for quite some time. From Wednesday 12th onwards, the office will be open for parents and carers to pop in with any general queries between: 8.45 - 9.10am every morning.

At this time the door will be open to allow for ventilation, and the dividing window will be open, so Mrs Foyle and Mrs Watts can actually hear what you are saying!

To support us with this, please ensure that you:

- Are wearing a mask at all times
- Sanitise hands upon entering the foyer
- Have no more than two people, socially distanced, in the foyer area at any one time

Lateral Flow Tests

We have had a couple of recent queries about testing children (or adults) who have symptoms of Covid 19. Lateral flow tests are for asymptomatic cases only, and are not designed for use with anyone showing symptoms. If you or your child have any symptoms of Covid 19 you must self isolate and book a PCR test. Please let us know if this is what you are doing, as we have a separate code for our register for this particular event.









Internet Safety using Google Parentzone

Pupils in years 3 and 4 will be coming home with a 'Be Internet Legends' kit over the next few days. This is part of our ongoing work on e-safety and teaching our children how to use the internet in a safe and respectful way. The kits allow you to build a character from the Google e-safety site whilst learning about aspects of keeping safe and being respectful online at the same time - full instructions are included!
