Reporting to Parents and Carers Update

In the summer term we invited parents and carers to complete a questionnaire about aspects of the school. One of the messages that came from this is that some of our families are concerned they do not know enough about their child's progress over the year at school. Prior to COVID we had a half termly reporting system that worked well, and we are going to reintroduce this in light of these concerns. The planned reporting for the coming year is as follows, and these will run alongside written reports, parent/carer evenings and any other meetings that are planned:

- Snapshot reports for Years 1- 4. These are short reports that update you half termly on your child's attendance, attitude, progress and/or targets:
 - Snapshot 1 end of Autumn 1 attendance and targets for the end of year
 - Snapshot 2 end of Autumn 2 attendance, attitudes and progress
 - Snapshot 3 end of Spring 1 attendance and attitude
 - Snapshot 4 end of Summer 1 attendance and attitude (spring 2 covered by full written report)
 - Snapshot 5 end of year attendance, attitude and end of year results

If you have any questions, concerns, or things you wish to celebrate with us, please remember we are always happy to meet with you - it is best to contact staff directly if you wish to talk anything through.

School Uniform

Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

Regardless of what year group your child is in, did you know that if you are receiving qualifying benefits, you could get extra £££'s for the school, and a free school meal if your child is in Years 3 or 4? In addition to this the school will qualify for extra funding known as the Pupil Premium. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 they will already receive a free school meal under a different government scheme, but if you are eligible for Pupil Premium and don't claim, the school is missing money and your child is missing extra benefits such as help with school uniform and the cost of school trips, and access to free holiday clubs run by Dorset Council! You can check if you are eligible here: dorsetcouncil.gov.uk/free-school-meals, or via telephone on 01305 221090. You can apply for the Pupil Premium at Apply for pupil premium - Dorset Council
