

## Pupil Premium Funding for Disadvantaged Children 2017/18

In 2017/18 the school was awarded £20,680 in funding for disadvantaged children. This includes children who have been eligible for free school meals in the past 6 years and those who are adopted. 16 pupils fell into this category and the funding was allocated as outlined below.
