

English

In English we are learning to write persuasive texts using our book for this half term which is called 'The Rhythm of the Rain'. As part of this unit the children will be identifying key features of persuasive writing and will have a go at using these in their own persuasive piece about not wasting water.

Science

In Science we are learning to Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with vibrating, recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear, find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced and recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

Maths

In Maths we are learning to measure length and perimeter in the first half of Autumn 2. After this we will then begin to focus on the first half of our multiplication and division unit of learning.



Rivers

What journey does a river go on?

Computing

In Computing we are learning to develop an understanding of how computers can be used to create and edit audio. The children will learn to identify input and output devices for recording and listening to sound. They will then practise recording, editing, and improving their own voice recordings.

Art

In Art we are learning about impressionism and the famous artist Monet. We will be learning about Monet's use of light and colour to create impressions of The River Thames.

Geography

In Geography we are learning to: track the journey of a river from its source to the sea. The children will be learning key vocabulary linked to rivers and will apply this to their learning on the river Frome.

French

In French we are learning to ask and answer questions using phrases such as 'qu'est-ce'. We will be learning to name items of clothing and use Christmas themed vocabulary.
