Winter in Dorset - Free Holiday Activities for Eligible Families

We're excited to announce that bookings for the <u>Winter in Dorset programme</u> open at 2pm on 21 November. This initiative, funded by the Department for Education, is part of Dorset Council's <u>Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme</u>, which aims to provide enriching activities and hot meals during school holidays. Children who receive benefit-related Free School Meals (FSM) can access free places and meals during the Easter, Summer, and Christmas holidays.

What's on offer:

- A wide range of activities including sports, arts and crafts, forest school, and cultural experiences
- Nutritious meals provided at every session
- Opportunities for children to make friends, learn new skills, and have fun in a safe environment

Eligible families must **pre-register** to receive a passcode via text or email. To register, email holidayactivities@dorsetcouncil.gov.uk with your child's name, date of birth, and school, or call 01305 221157. If you registered for a previous programme, you do **not** need to register again.
