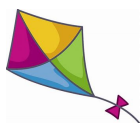


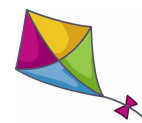


Broadmayne First School Weekly Reminder

Reception

Phonics: During phonics we will begin to explore The Basics 4. This will be a light touch approach to introduce the children to sounds they will learn in Year One. At home, please continue to support with The Basics 3 and tricky words.

Writing: As writers we continue to focus on writing simple sentences - for example: The sun is hot.

Maths: During Maths we will revisit grouping and sharing.

PE: We are so proud of the children's fantastic attitude to swimming lessons. Thank you, Reception for your wonderful listening!

Topic: During topic we have been exploring pirates - making treasure maps and designing flags. This week, we explore sea creatures.

Year 1

Here is what we will be getting up to next week:

English: We will be starting our unit on Call and Response poetry. We will be learning how to rhyme and using this to write a class call and response poem.

Dictation: Your gift is here but don't open it!

Phonics: We continue our Switch It Mitch with o, ue, u-e and ew.

Maths: We are finishing our unit on Time this week.

Science: We are exploring the difference between wild animals and pets.

Geography: We will be explaining how the people of Mugurameno protect themselves and their homes from wild animals – and how they make use of animals in their everyday lives.

Year 2

A glimpse of our learning next week:

Maths:

Year 2's are looking back on multiplication and division this week to prepare them for year 2's. We will look at some core strategies such as repeated addition, making groups and the link between multiplication and division. Anton is a great resource for this, and we will have homework based on this as well.

English:

Next week, the children will be revisiting the writing skills they have learned throughout Year 2 by identifying them in texts, improving sentences and writing sections of a story. This will help build their confidence and prepare them to independently apply these skills in their own writing.

We are learning to spell: recapping our year 2 spellings from this year!

Science:

Children this week will be thinking about animal adaptations! We will be thinking about what features animals have to help them to survive in their habitats.

Computing:

We are continuing to develop our skills as programmers! We will be creating an algorithm in which the children have a different starting block that transitions to one of their backgrounds.

History:

We will be looking at souvenirs from the past today and thinking about how we can design a new souvenir for our seaside holidays.

P.E:

Swimming - Monday and Friday - please remember swimming goggles!

Reminders:

Transfer day - Tuesday - Children will go straight to their new class and spend the day with their new teacher Mrs Felgate!

Forest school - Thursday morning - Long sleeves if possible, depending on the heat and sturdy shoes.

Year 3

Weekly news: It is transfer day on Tuesday - our class will be Year 4 for the day!

We have our picnic presentation for the Kingfisher Award on Wednesday next week. This will be from 2:30 at Maiden Castle Farm. The children have the option to present or come along to watch. The children presenting are asked to arrive for 2:30. Please note those wishing to attend will need to be taken by parents. Please see separate email for further details and the

Year 3 also have Forest School on Thursday afternoon. Please ensure that the children have long sleeves, full length legwear and sturdy shoes.

Our learning this week -

Maths: We will be reviewing our learning this term and then concentrating on the 3x, 4x and 8x table.

English: We will be using our taught skills to write our own adventure story based on Arthur and the Golden Rope.

We are learning to spell:

Science: We will be reviewing our learning about magnets and looking at how magnets are used in the wider world in more depth.

Heartsmart: We will be looking at how to deal with change. This will focus on preparing for transition into Year 4.

History: We will be looking at how Anglo-Saxon people worked together and supported each other in their villages through 'kinship'. We will focus on the different roles within a community.

PE: Swimming will be on Monday and Friday as before.

Reminders: Please let me know if you are able to attend the picnic on Wednesday.
It is Forest School on Thursday.

Year 4

We would like to wish all Oak class an exciting transfer day at whichever school they are going to on Tuesday!

A snippet of our learning next week:

English:

We are learning to spell: experimentally, natural, naturally, occasion, occasionally

Maths: The children have been really enjoying our unit on statistics and learning how to interpret the keys to read pictograms and charts. We complete this unit next week before moving onto our geometry unit looking at plotting positions and co-ordinates.

Science: The children will be continuing their research project into human impact on habitats. The children have been given the opportunity to use a range of recording methods including; Powerpoint, speech, poster, leaflet.

PE: Swimming lessons will continue on Monday and Friday as usual. Please send your child's swimming kit to school everyday next week. If it gets too hot we may be able to take the children swimming.

Music: Play practise continues. The children are doing a wonderful job and we can't wait for you to see our performance!

Homework:

Please could we ask all children to practise, practise and practise learning their lines for the play over the weekend! It makes such a big difference if they know their lines and the performances are fast approaching!

Class reminders:

Tuesday is transfer day, please refer to communication from your chosen middle school for timings of drop off and pick off.

We will send any inhalers home with your child on Monday afternoon so they can take them with them to transfer day.
