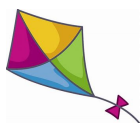


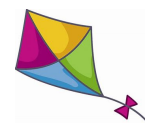


Broadmayne First School Weekly Reminder

Reception

Phonics: During phonics we continue to introduce The Basics 4 - please focus on The Basics 3 at home.

Writing: As writers, we will share the story The Little Red Riding Hood and explore the traditional tale. We will continue to focus on those foundational skills such as finger spaces, sentence

writing, capital letters and full stops.

Maths: As mathematicians, we will revisit the key concepts taught this year - odds and evens, more and less and the beginnings of addition and subtraction.

PE: Swimming on Mondays and Fridays as usual! We are so impressed with the children's wonderful attitudes to their swimming lessons. They have made great progress with their confidence in the pool.

Books: We will be giving the children their core subject books to bring home, alongside learning from their Learning Folders. Please provide a named, strong carrier bag for this.

Year 2

A glimpse of our learning next week:

Maths:

This week we are revisiting shapes, capacity and time, we will also have some time on TTRS (times table rock stars).

English:

In English this week, we will be revisiting some previously taught skills, as well as using contractions and possessive apostrophes (singular) in our writing.

We are learning to spell: recapping our year 2 spellings from this year.

Phonics:

We will be looking at homophones this week.

DT:

We will be trying different root vegetables in DT this week, using our knowledge of fruits and vegetables and making our very own 'sensational salad'.

Year 3

Weekly news: We have had a lovely week! Our awards picnic for the Kingfisher Trust project went very well. We received great praise for all of the work that the class had submitted and they were very impressed with how the children were able to talk about their learning on the day - a big thank you to everyone who made that a success. We also enjoyed our swimming slot and our extra forest time on Thursday.

Our learning this week -

Maths: We will continue to revise our learning and will focus on the 3x, 4x and 8x table so that the children are ready for Year 4. If you are able to rehearse these at home it would be greatly appreciated. We use this [song](#) to help us with the 8x table.

English: We will be completing our adventure stories!

We are learning to spell: This week we will be focusing on words with 'sion'. These will include collision, comprehension, confusion, division, erosion, explosion, invasion, revision, television, tension.

Science: We will be revising our learning this term.

Heartsmart: We will be reflecting on our learning this term and preparing ourselves for Year 4.

History: We will be rounding up our learning by looking at how Britain changed over time, from the Roman period through to the end of the Anglo-Saxon period.

PE: Swimming will be on Monday and Friday as before.

Reminders: Please can library books be brought back on Monday.

Year 4

Please could every child bring in a named plastic bag on Monday for us to start collating all of their books and work to bring home. There's a lot, because they've been working so hard!! So perhaps one of the big bags for life bags.

A snippet of our learning next week:

English: In English we will be finishing off our playscripts based on our favourite memories of our time in Broadmayne. The children will then have an opportunity to act out their playscripts in small groups.

Phonics: We will be enjoying homophones this week.

We are learning to spell: ball, bawl, brake, break, heal, heel, mail, male, rain, reign

Maths: We will continue with our 'Shape' unit and drawing 2D shapes and translating them onto a grid.

DT: We won't be doing DT this week due to the play performances.

PE: Swimming lessons will continue as usual on Monday and Friday this week. Please remember swimming hats and googles!
