Sadly however, Wilson, Kerry and Mike's dog, was killed in the crash. You may know (or at least heard!) Wilson from school, and he spent many happy hours with us as a puppy and visited regularly as he grew up. The staff are devastated at this sad news and send all our love and support to Kerry, who is heartbroken as you can imagine. We will be installing a small remembrance piece for Wilson, and he will be forever remembered in the beautiful plaque that Kerry presented to the school when she left and which we will be installing soon at the front of the school.
