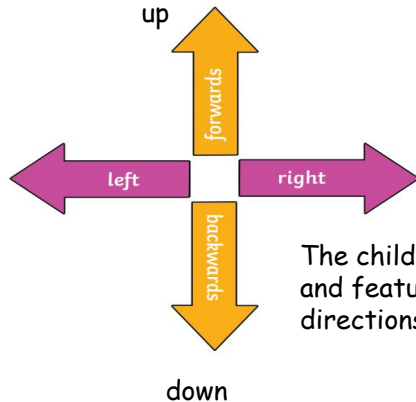


Compass directions



The children will learn to describe locations and features on maps using compass directions and directional language.



Aerial photograph - a photograph that is taken from high up looking down. They may be familiar with the term 'birds-eye view'. The children will use aerial photos to recognise landmarks and basic **human features** (eg roads, bridges, buildings) and **physical features** (rivers, mountains etc). We will even look at some photos taken from space.

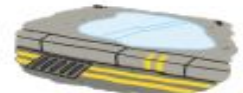
