Can you hold up 3 fingers using two hands (e.g. 1 on one hand and 2 on the other). Don't forget to check them on your nose!

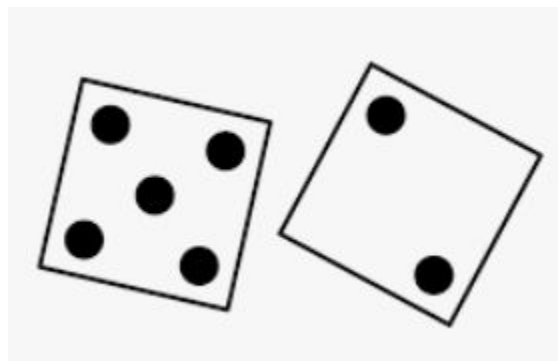
Recognising digits 1 – 10

More than and less than

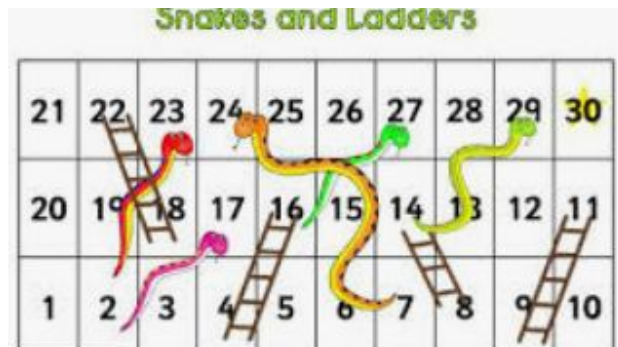


Which dice has more spots?

Can you add 2 dice together by counting all the spots? (for example 5 add 2 is 7)

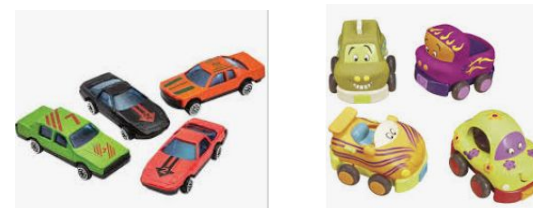
Use dice to **count on** along a number line. Don't forget to count the jumps (you don't count the one that you start on)
