Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have all had the opportunity to enjoy the school's Winter Wonderland - the elves were certainly very busy over the weekend putting everything together! A huge thank you to our FABS and to every family that came along and helped out - it looks amazing and is putting a smile on everyone's face!

#### **COVID Update**

As you will be aware, due to the high case rates in our local area, Public Health Dorset and Dorset Council provided <u>additional guidance for educational settings</u> across the county to reduce transmission of COVID-19, with a review at the end of November. These measures have been reviewed with local and regional partners and it has been agreed that they should be extended until the end of the school winter term on 17 December.

- Our local case rates remain significantly above the England average, and are now above the South West average
- Case rates are not coming down quickly, and the decrease is much slower than in other regions
- Across the county, case rates are over 1700 for 0 15 year olds

With regard to this the school will continue to pause large group gatherings, limit the amount of visitors to the school and ask that masks be worn by adults in communal areas. We continue to prioritise good ventilation and high standards of hygiene.

The school strongly recommends that children with any cold-like symptoms are kept at home and undertake a PCR. If negative for COVID individuals should still wait until 24 hours post fever before coming back to school. Colds and other non-Covid symptoms are circulating but in the first instance cardinal symptoms should be treated as possible COVID and trigger isolation and testing. This is the case even if others in the setting /group have tested negative for similar symptoms.

Can I remind everyone that lateral flow tests are not intended to be used on anyone exhibiting symptoms - they are designed for asymptomatic cases only. A PCR should always be sought for anyone with symptoms. The school cannot accept a negative LFT as proof that someone with symptoms is able to attend the setting.

By working together we can try and limit the spread of the virus within the school, particularly in the run up to Christmas. The last thing I would want is any of our families having COVID over the Christmas period - this happened to me last year and I can assure you it did not make for a happy family time!











## **Christmas and Nativity Update 2**

In the light of the above information, and with growing concerns about the spread of a new variant of the virus, the school has decided that we cannot invite parents and carers in to watch our nativity performance this year.

As you can probably imagine, we are all really disappointed about this, as we have spent a long time planning for this event, which is the highlight of the Autumn term. Rehearsals continue as usual however, and all children will still get to experience performing on stage, as we film and then broadcast the play instead. Filming will take place on Friday 10th December.

In order to be able to have a celebration together, we are inviting everyone back to school for **5pm on Monday 13th December** for a Christmas song celebration. Please come along and join us on the school field, where the children will sing to you a selection of songs they have learned from the nativity production. Please bring along lanterns to light your way! This is, of course, weather dependent, so fingers crossed for a clear and calm evening in which to celebrate together.

#### **Christmas Market**

We are all looking forward to the FABS Christmas Market which takes place this Friday from 6pm. There will be a huge range of stalls for your Christmas shopping needs, as well as food and drink and entertainment, including some festive singing from our school choir, the Starlings. Please come along and support the FABS and the school - all money raised will go towards supporting our children!
