Heartsmart

This half term in our HeartSmart lessons and assemblies, we will be learning that 'No way through isn't true!' We want our children to know that when they face challenging situations, they don't need to give up, and that there is always a way through. In every situation-maths, reading, friendships, changing schools- there is always an opportunity for children to respond with hope. We want them to know that the first part of finding the solution and way through is by believing that there is one. Our focus this half term is to help our children to grow in perseverance and to put this into practice in the classroom. This will link with our current half term focus on the value of respect, and the importance of respecting ourselves as well as other people.

STEM Week

Following on from our recent national award in science, this week we are excited to have our first theme week since the recent lockdown. All week we will be linking our learning to the STEM subjects (science, technology, engineering and maths), with a focus on STEM careers and The Jurassic Coast. On Monday we were very pleased to welcome the Science Dome into the school hall- we have been waiting a year for them to visit! Each class visited the dome and were amazed by the enormous prehistoric creatures they encountered! We continue the week with visits from parents who are sharing their STEM careers with us all, alongside a wide variety of STEM based projects - we are finding links to other subjects too, including art and DT!

Virtual Walk along the Jurassic Coast

As part of our STEM Week, we thought we would add in a link to health and well being, and so we are running a Virtual Walk along the Jurassic Coast. At 95 miles long, the Jurassic Coast is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which allows you to travel through 185 million years of the Earth's history! We would like to see how far along we can travel virtually, and are inviting all our families to record how far they have travelled in the week under their own steam (walking, running, cycling, scooting - no motorised vehicles or horse power!).
